Ms. Swineford spoke with the group about replacing a tenor saxophone. Currently she has a tenor saxophone that is in pretty bad shape and the cost of fixing the saxophone exceeds the cost of just replacing it. She is going to do a little more research on cost for the tenor saxophone for the band program. Will revisit at the next Music Boosters Meeting on September 28.

The kids are doing well learning the music and with site reading. Continue prepping for the football games.

The band is having some difficulty with finding trumpet players for band. 2015/16 school year numbers are 23 students in the middle school choir, 40 students in the high school choir, 16 students in the sixth grade band, 21 students in the 7/8th grade band, 23 students in the high school band.

Ms. Swineford is trying to plan something fun for in the spring for the students. Either performing at Cedar Point or in front of the Rock-N-Roll Hall of Fame for example. She is going to try to lock this in by October so she can plan properly over the rest of the year. This would be close to 100 kids.

Ashley Report:

Things are going well with the Sweethearts they are down to one day a week practice and are ready for the half time show.

Old Business Report:

The gloves/shoes are in and will be given out this week to the students that have paid for them.

Locker decorations are done and ready to be hung up.

Senior gifts will stay as they are for this year. Candy goody bags and blankets. Next year we will plan on having more time to discuss with the parents of the seniors the option of purchasing the banners or purchase them as the senior gifts. We will revisit this again in the spring. We want to make sure that the seniors are being recognized and represented.

Deb Ritchey touched quickly on the upcoming events Cross Country Invitational, Selling microwave popcorn during volleyball games. Music Boosters will have a presence at both to sell popcorn.

Discussed the football programs and making sure that the band patrons are listed in the football programs. Alyssa McQuate is the contact for this. Also, at the home football games the music boosters will be selling donuts, popcorn, and glow sticks. For the first home football

game we are looking at ordering 75 dozen Krispy Kreme donuts to start and see how well that does. The first 25 dozen will be free. Erin Beebe will continue to watch for coupons.

Third Quarter Update:

Rashanee updated on the third quarter meal plan for the season. To date she has all the games covered with the exception of the October 16 game which still had some open donation slots for food items.

Homecoming Update:

For Homecoming 3rd quarter we will have Krispy Kreme donuts and cidar. Boosters will be ordering 125 dozen donuts and Erin Beebe will be providing the cidar. Everyone was in agreeance that we will be honoring Mrs. Bennett with the Homecoming festivities. Working on coordinating the music and the alumni band practice. Ms. Swineford

is trying to get the music on the website for the alumni which is www.mapletonmusicdept.weebly.com also we are going to try and link this with the Music Booster e-mail. Alumni rehearsal will be held on September 29th at 6:30pm for 30 minutes. Kids will be asked to arrive at 5:15 and alumni to arrive at 5:30 for practice before the game.

Zap Update:

We are unable to get cookie dough as they have in the past. The top sellers will be getting money prizes to the top three sellers. And we will be using the donated 5lb chocolate bar for a raffle prize.

Raffle Update:

Tracy Gibbs gave an update of the raffle donations and stated that we are currently up to 10 donations confirmed. See the attached sheet for the current list of donations. The only donation in question would be from Salt fork Lodge for a one night stay. We actually have to purchase the gift certificate for \$45.34 which includes tax. Tracy is going to do a little more research into this item from Salt Fork. It was also discussed about having this as a separate raffle item at a separate event.
