The Mapleton Music Boosters offers \$50 scholarships to students who are interested in attending dance camp in order to help defray some of the costs for students and their families

Students interested in applying need to write a "short" (less than one page) essay explaining: 1) why do you want to attend the camp and 2) why you should receive a scholarship.

Time frame to apply/date due?

Once applicant has returned from dance camp, they will be asked to attend a Boosters meeting to give a brief report on what they learned and how they will use what they learned.

Following the report, the Music Boosters will then reimburse the Sweethearts for the \$50 per scholarship/girl.
