Hi everybody!

Here's the info I have on a Tenor sax. Used tenors aren't a great deal, as you can get a new one for a little bit more. John Bell has a new Tenor Sax by Antigua. They usually run \$1500. He's helped me out and we can get it for \$1000. I asked if there is any more wiggle room than that, and he said that's his best offer. I can ask again.

Mike Metcalf has a used tenor for \$895.

At this point, I need a tenor sax more than I need a tuba. Yes, I still want the tubas. However, the student that I would like to switch to tenor (which John Bell loaned to me for a couple weeks. I have it till next Thursday.) has been doing GREAT on this horn. We can put off the tubas if you'd like.

Our instrument inventory here at Mapleton is OLD. Many of the wind instruments we have were purchased 20+ years ago. You know I don't like to spend money, but we are in a situation where we have made some money this year, and the program needs some items.

I can chat with you more about this during third quarter tonight, if you'd like.

Side note #1: the baritone repair I asked for came out to \$20.

Side Note#2: our bass drum mallets are falling apart. We will need to purchase new mallets very soon. I can email prices in a separate email, if you'd like. Just let me know.

Side note #3: here are some pics of the new tenor I have on loan from John Bell at Pelligrinos. I also included side by side with the old tenor.
